6. Click the blue button and wait for the blue line to creep across the screen while it downloads.





10. Click  to agree to the terms.

11. Click  for the microphone to work.

12. I usually uncheck the 1<sup>st</sup> box so that it does not start up when I start my computer and leave the 2<sup>nd</sup> box checked so that it puts a shortcut icon in my screen task bar. That way I can easily find it in the task bar without using the menu:
